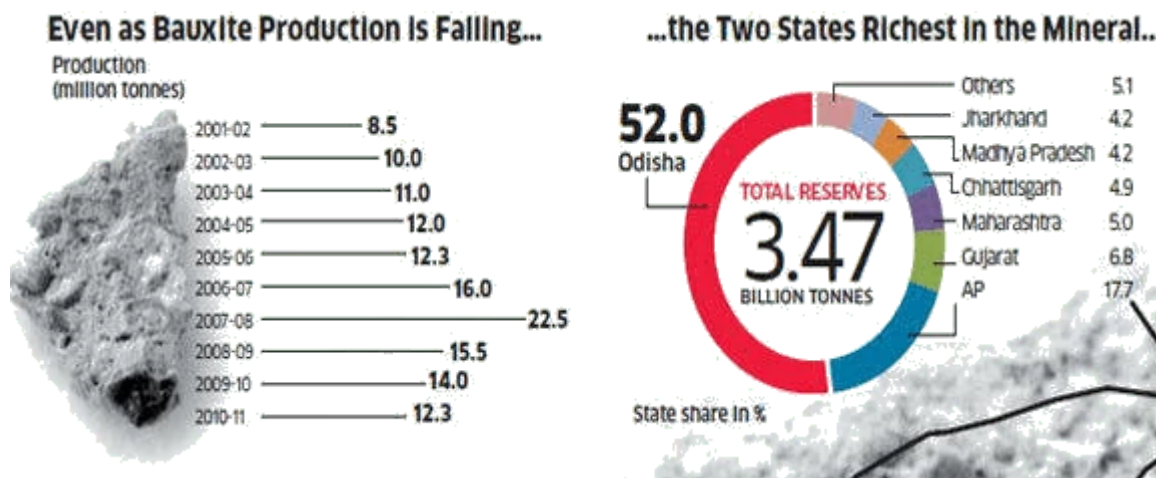


Image of Dr. T. K Chand Gets Knowledge Excellence Award
