6. China National Petroleum Corporation- It is 6th biggest employer with 1.6 million employees. It is Chinese state-run company.
7. State Grid Corporation of China- It is 7th biggest employer with 1.5 million employees.
8. Indian Railways- 1.4 million staff.
9. Indian Army- 1.3 million employees.
10. Hon Hai Precision Factory- It is known around world as Foxconn, a leading electronics manufacturer. It is placed at 10th position with 1.2 million employees.
