- Document required to prove your identity.
- In India, you'll need a valid passport.
- Your original passport (not photocopies) which clearly shows your full name, photograph and signature.
- ETS does not set any age, qualification, timing related pre-requisites.

- Hence, there will be a range of eligibility criteria set by universities that accept GRE scores.
- They may have minimum age, experience and qualification related filters for each of their programs.
