2. India has a bicameral legislature system in the Centre.

Reason: Bicameral means 2 chamber house. So, India has Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha at the center.

3. The power is divided among the 2 list in India.

4. The Lok Sabha is the Permanent house of the Indian Parliament.

Reason: Rajya Sabha is the permanent house of the Parliament. Only 1/3 of its member retire every 2 year. Lok Sabha is dissolved after every 5 year and new Lok Sabha is constituted after the general election.

Reason: The President can nominate not more than 2 members of Anglo-Indian community if he/she thinks that this community is not adequately represented in Lok Sabha.

Reason: To be a member of Lok Sabha a person has to be of age 25 year or more. For Rajya Sabha a person has to be of the age 30 or more.

Reason: A money bill can only be introduced in Lok Sabha. It is one of the exclusive powers of Lok Sabha.
