

Preparation Tips for UGC NTA NET Economics

NTA now conducts NET Exam and there are 2 papers in all.

- Paper - I is General Paper for all – includes Teaching & Research Aptitude and is a common exam which consists of a total of 100 marks with 50 questions
- Paper II on sociology consists of 200 Marks with 100 questions

All papers are most important because to qualify in next papers you have to score up to sectional cutoff.

Note: There is no negative marking so candidates have to attempt all questions.

Here is Some Preparation Tips for UGC NTA NET Economics in 3 Simple Steps:

This Tips will helps you to get quality Marks particularly for Economics after clearing paper I

Step 1: Make Time Table for Preparation

- First off all make time table and allot 100 day for preparation of Paper I & II.
- According to this timetable, divide each topic week wise.
- Look at the syllabus [for Economics - NTA NET](#)
- Check out the extensive booklist available at [Examrace for Economics Subject](#)
- During preparation time, make summary notes for each and every topic
- Don't waste time to deciding which topic is most important and which is not, give equal attention to each topic
- If possible Make List of week with topic you allotted and one extra column which is about you successfully completed this topic or not, Because it will helps you later when you revise syllabus (it's silly but try it)
- Do not depends on just one material try to get more and more information from different books, Wikipedia , various blogs and websites and video tutorials.
