Scholarships:

About 1000 scholarships are awarded for different stages of education:

- **For class-XI to XII:** Scholarships of Rs. 1250/-
- **For undergraduate and Post-graduates:** Scholarships of Rs. 2000/-
- Amount of scholarship for Ph. D. is fixed in accordance with UGC norms.

Reservation:

- **SC category:** 15 % for students
- **ST category:** 7.5 % for students
- For physically challenged group of students 4%

Qualifying Marks:

- **General category:** 40 % in each paper
- **SC, ST and PH category:** 32 % in each paper

Eligibility:

- All students of Class X studying in recognized schools are eligible to appear for the stage-I examination, concluded by States/UTs, in which schools are located.
- Students registered under Open Distance Learning (ODL) will also be eligible for scholarship.
- Provided below 18 years students (as on 1st July of Particular Year), the student is not employed and he/she is appearing in class X examination for the first time.
