Tewari, a 1976-batch Indian Revenue Service officer, was posted as the Member (Legislation and Computerisation) in CBDT. The appointment was taken after Sudha Sharma retired on 28 February 2014. Tewari has earlier served in various positions in the Income Tax Department, including as a Chief Commissioner in the national capital.
